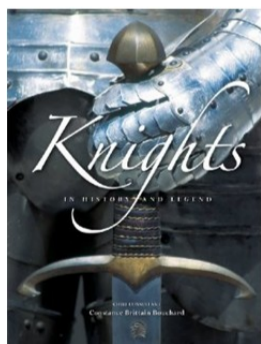
## GOT SPIRIT? WE DO!
