APA AND MLA CITATION STYLES

As you might already know, two notable style guides for writing and citing research papers have newly-updated versions. Changes include:

Modern Languages Association (MLA):

Resources are now distinguished as either Print or Web. Unless your professor requests, you no longer need to include the web address. Example:

Purdue OWL. "MLA Formatting and Style Guide." *The Purdue OWL*. Purdue U Writing Lab, 10 May 2008. Web. 15 Nov. 2009.

American Psychological Association (APA):

Unfortunately, there have been many [complaints about the changes](#). Basic rules include no longer using retrieval dates for online resources and using either a DOI number, or if there is no DOI, a URL. Example:

Purdue University Online Writing Lab (OWL) (Last edited date available in the gray box at the top of the resource). *APA Formatting and Style Guide*. Retrieved from <http://owl.english.purdue.edu/owl/resource/560/01/>.
