We are all trying to help control these costs. Of course we can't photocopy entire books for students due to copyright, and if the library were to purchase textbooks, we wouldn't have funds for much else.

One option is to use the library's [course reserve system](#). Do you have an extra copy of a textbook? Or perhaps we have it in our [catalog](#). We accept up to 3 copies of a single textbook (based on class size) for the semester. Students can check these materials out for in-library use for 3 hours at a time. The library also handles e-reserves, which are perfect for single book chapters or articles (in black and white only).
