U-BORROW DISCONTINUED— USE [E-Z BORROW](#) FOR FREE BOOKS LONG DISTANCE

A mid-year reduction in the budget of the Keystone Library Network has prompted the elimination of the U-Borrow interlibrary borrowing service with the other PASSHE libraries.

Use the number on your Cal U Photo ID Card to request a book with the fast, free service [E-ZBorrow](#) instead! Located under the "Finding Information" column on the [Library Home page](#) or within [PILOT](#) in the header and footer. E-Z Borrow searches more than 50 other libraries, including Pitt, Penn State, and Carnegie Mellon. It can take as little as a week before you'll get an email letting you know you can pick it up in the library.

Disclaimers: trying to get a textbook to use the whole semester will not work. Loan period of items is 21 days, with the option to renew one time. Some popular reading or very new items may not come through, either.
